ABOUT THE NANYANG ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS

Established in 1938, the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA), founding member of the University of the Arts Singapore, is Singapore's pioneer arts institution. The academy is known for its rigorous and high-quality curriculum, innovative and practitioners-led teaching approach, diverse artistic creations and community outreach.

NAFA has nurtured 13 recipients of the Cultural Medallion — Singapore's highest accolade bestowed on art practitioners who have significantly impacted arts and culture. Another 15 alumni have been presented the Young Artist Award. NAFA graduates are creative changemakers, highly skilled, and well-rounded in inter-disciplinary approaches. Many of the academy's alumni have gone on to make their mark in the professional arts scene, clinching awards at prestigious international competitions such as Cannes Lions, Prix de la Photographie, Paris, Red Dot Design Awards, and Venice Biennale.

The academy offers full-time diploma, bachelor's and master's degree programmes across three faculties: Faculty of Art & Design comprising the School of Fine Art, School of 3D Design, School of Design & Media, as well as the School of Fashion Studies; Faculty of Performing Arts comprising School of Dance, School of Music, and School of Theatre; Faculty of Interdisciplinary Practices comprising School of Arts Management and School of Interdisciplinary Arts. Diploma

programmes are aligned with the degree programmes offered in partnership with top universities in the world, namely University of the Arts London (ranked 2nd globally for Art and Design since 2019), Royal College of Music, London (ranked first globally for Performing Arts in 2022), Central Conservatory of Music, Beijing, and under the umbrella of University of the Arts Singapore.

NAFA's programmes are designed and delivered by experienced art educators and leading industry practitioners. The academic schools regularly review and refine their curriculum to reflect the changing needs of the industry.

As an advocate of lifelong learning, NAFA dedicates its effort to developing a greater appreciation of the arts for all ages. The NAFA Arts Preschool (formerly NAFA Arts Kindergarten), is the first arts-themed preschool in Singapore. The School of Young Talents offers weekend courses in art, dance, drama and music to 4- to 18-year-olds. For adults, the Centre for Lifelong Education offers enrichment courses and part-time certificate programmes.

With a rich heritage, established track record and an unwavering dedication to the highest standards of arts education, NAFA strives to live up to its mission of "inspiring learning and growth through the arts". NAFA DISTINGUISHED ALUMINI AWARD 2024

DR HO KAH LEONG

DIPLOMA IN FINE ARTS, 1956



The award is conferred to outstanding NAFA alumni who have contributed to excellence in the arts and design as well as the development of the arts scene in Singapore. This award is to accord them further recognition for their achievements.

The award was presented for the first time in 2009.



Dr Ho Kah Leong is a distinguished figure in Singapore's artistic landscape, with a career marked by significant achievements in education, politics and the arts. Educated at Chung Cheng High School and Nanyang University, Dr Ho began his professional journey in education before transitioning into politics. He was elected as a Member of Parliament (MP) in 1966, a role he held with dedication until 1996. His parliamentary career saw him rise through the ranks to become Parliamentary Secretary in 1981 and Senior Parliamentary Secretary in 1984.

Despite the demands of his political career, Dr Ho's passion for the arts remained unwavering. His artistic journey began in secondary school and continued throughout his life, even as he navigated his political responsibilities. In 1997, after serving as an MP for three decades, Dr Ho was appointed Principal of the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA), a role he held until 2003. During his tenure, he made significant contributions, including raising funds required to build NAFA's permanent campuses along Bencoolen Street.

Dr Ho's artistic pursuits are diverse, including oil paintings created en plein air, Chinese calligraphy, and woodcut prints. Known for his bold, distinctive strokes, Dr Ho's oil paintings and calligraphy reflect his deep engagement with the arts. His woodcut prints, a form he has revitalised from its popularity from the 1950s to 1970s, have received positive acclaim in numerous group exhibitions. During his political career, Dr Ho frequently officiated at exhibitions and contributed to charitable auctions. He has also held several art exhibitions for charity, frequently donating his works to support various causes.

Dr Ho's solo exhibitions highlight his artistic evolution, beginning with *Nostalgic Scenes* at the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry in 1990. This was followed by Beauty Lion City at the NAFA Gallery in 1991 and Scenes Splendour at the same venue in 1993. In 1997, Dr Ho presented Passion for Art: Solo Exhibition of Ho Kah Leong's Location Painting at SooBin Gallery, further solidifying his reputation in the art community. His work continued to gain prominence with IdvIlic Nanyang at SooBin Gallery in 2000, and Idyllic Tropics at Central Gallery in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, in 2001. The year 2002 saw Beauty of Nature at the NAFA Gallery, and in 2006, he exhibited Parks in Garden City at ARTium. Ministry of Information, Communications and the Arts. The following years included Last Kampung of Singapore: Lorong Buangkok at Tembusu Art Gallery in 2007, and Poetic Ubin at Black Earth Art Museum in 2008. Dr Ho's work continued to capture attention with Splendour of Lakes and Hills in 2009, and Rhythm of the Sea in 2011, both held at Tembusu Art Gallery. In 2013, he showcased Lion City Rediscovered at both Tembusu Art Gallery and ION Art Gallery. Continuing his impactful presence in the art world, his more recent exhibitions include Exotic Landscapes at Tembusu Art Gallery and The Art Space @ Suntec in 2015, and Trilogy Art of Ho Kah Leong at The Art Space by Natalie Wong in 2024.

Dr Ho has received numerous accolades for his contributions, including the NTUC Friend of Labour Medal in 1981 and the Peru Cultural Medal in 2000. In August 2001, he was honoured with an Honorary Doctorate (Doctor of Philosophy in Arts) from Wisconsin International University, United States.

An exceptional and inspiring individual, Dr Ho Kah Leong's diverse achievements and contributions stand as a testament to his profound commitment to public service and the arts, leaving a lasting legacy that continues to inspire future generations.

NAFA DISTINGUISHED ALUMINI AWARD 2024

DR DARIUS LIM KIAN SIONG

DIPLOMA IN MUSIC, 2006 AND BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS) MUSIC, 2009

About the Award

The award is conferred to outstanding NAFA alumni who have contributed to excellence in the arts and design as well as the development of the arts scene in Singapore. This award is to accord them further recognition for their achievements.

The award was presented for the first time in 2009.



Dr Darius Lim Kian Siong, a distinguished Singaporean conductor-composer, is celebrated for his innovative contributions. and visionary approach to the field of choral music. As the Founder and Artistic Director of Voices of Singapore (VOS). Dr Lim has significantly transformed Singapore's choral landscape, uniting communities through the art of singing. Under his leadership, VOS has expanded to include over 30 choirs and 1.300 singers, ranging from award-winning choirs to community-focused choirs serving the underprivileged communities, such as seniors with dementia and children with special needs. The annual VOS Festival exemplifies his commitment to advancing choral music, offering a platform for thousands of choristers across the nation to promote a Singing Singapore.

In addition to his role at VOS, Dr Lim holds several influential positions in the local and global music scene. He serves as CEO of The Voice Company, a Board Member of the International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM), a Council Member of the Asia Pacific Choral Council, and the Board Chairman of the World Alliance of Children's Choirs.

Dr Lim's international acclaim is further evidenced by his invitations to adjudicate and lecture at major events, including the World Choir Games, the Asia-Pacific Choral Symposium, and the Bali International Choral Festival. His compositions, known for their lyrical, dramatic, instrumental and theatrical qualities, have been performed by esteemed ensembles such as Voces8, the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra, and the National Youth Choirs of Great Britain. Noteworthy recent projects include his role as the commissioned composer for the 2023 World

Symposium on Choral Music in Istanbul, Set-piece Composer for the Singapore Youth Festival Arts Presentations, and Composer-in-Residence for National Concerts at Carnegie Hall.

Dr Lim's innovative projects also include the Singapore Virtual Choir Project, which united 900 Singaporeans during the pandemic, and a significant recording of the National Anthem with the Singapore Armed Forces Band. His leadership in the 250-strong Inclusive Choir at the 2024 National Day Parade, performing a medley of songs including his composition *Our Story*, highlights his dedication to inclusivity and national pride.

Dr Lim made history as the first Singaporean composer to release a full album of his works on NAXOS Records, the world's largest classical label. His impact on the music industry was further recognised in 2021 when he presented "The Voices of Singapore – Strengthening a Nation Through Choral Singing" at TEDx.

Dr Lim has been actively involved in events at the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA), where he has served as a member of the NAFA Music Alumni Chapter since 2021. He has also contributed as an Alumni Speaker during NAFA Career Week 2023, initiated the Music Alumni Company Tour for School of Music students, organised the Music Alumni Company Attachments and Observations for School of Music students at VOS Choirs, and served on the committee for the '85 Years in 85 Minutes' NAFA Music Alumni Chapter Concert.

Dr Darius Lim's visionary approach and tireless dedication continue to inspire and elevate the global choral music community.

About the Award

The Embassy of Peru Award was first presented in 2006. It is presented to the most outstanding degree graduate at the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts. The award recognises the all-round achievements of the recipient who possesses strong academic performance, good attributes including discipline, diligence and leadership qualities, as well as contributions towards the class, Academy and arts community.

The award is a Tumi from Peru. It is made of solid silver. The Tumi is one of the symbols of Peru. It has its origin in one of the main cultures in ancient Peru between 1050 – 1476 AD, known as the Chimú Culture. One of the important accomplishments of the Chimú was the establishment of the goldsmith workshops. Among the most famous pieces made were the great ceremonial knives called the Tumi. During the ancient times in Peru, it was used as a knife in ceremonies and surgeries. Later on, it evolved into an art object.

Peru is a country where gold, silver and other metals with artistic character are in abundance and so the Tumi is symbolic of the art and culture of Peru. In Peru, hanging a Tumi on a wall brings good luck.

About the Award

The Wu Tsung Kan Book Prize is a premier award for all-round excellence. Two awards are presented to exceptional students from amongst the best diploma graduates at the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts. The recipients are selected based on academic excellence and other outstanding achievements.

Mr Wu Tsung Kan served as Principal of NAFA from 1979 to 1988. He had a long and distinguished career in Singapore's education sector. Among his many significant achievements in NAFA were the introduction of new diploma courses in Music, Dance and Design, a revamp of the curriculum and assessment system, ensuring the building of new campus facilities including an art gallery, and establishing new sources of funding. The Academy grew in national and international stature as a result of Mr Wu's vision and dedication.

Programme Notes from the Composer

Dr Zechariah Goh Toh Chai (NAFA Class of 1989)

The processional music opens in the style of a small fanfare, soon breaks into a fun-filled and festive Malay village scene. The percussion instruments featured here are all Malay ethnic drums, such as the kompang, rebana, mirwas, and darbuka. The percussion parts act as a guide for the musicians, who will improvise with elements of interlocking rhythms represented by the kompang players, along with call-and-response interactions among the other musicians.

The closing recessional work is scored for saxophones, trombones, and percussion. This unique combination of saxophones and trombones represents a village band procession, accompanied by traditional Malay percussion instruments. The processional music includes the Malay folk song Lompat si Katak Lompat ("Jump! Frogs, Jump!"), while the recessional music presents Air Pasang Pagi ("Morning Tides") in the style of the traditional Malay dance, Joget. Lompat si Katak Lompat serves as a metaphor for the "leap of faith" taken by students as they enter NAFA, and the Joget symbolises their lively dance out of NAFA and into society with joyful anticipation.
