Diploma in Design (Interior and Spatial)

This programme focuses on human-centred spatial design that responds to how people live, work and gather. Through studio experimentation and real-world projects, students learn to create immersive, inclusive and emotionally resonant environments while developing a critical understanding of how space influences behaviour, wellbeing and social responsibility in a changing design landscape.



Diploma in Design (Furniture and 3D Crafts)

This diploma develops designers through material-led practice, combining handcraft and digital fabrication to create jewellery, lifestyle objects and sculptural forms. Rooted in Southeast Asian heritage and contemporary culture, the programme equips students to design with purpose, market awareness and sustainability – preparing graduates to launch independent brands, contribute to the circular economy, or innovate within the craft and design industries.

Diploma in Design (Landscape and Architecture)

What does it mean to design with nature in mind? This programme develops designers who work with — not against — nature. You will learn to shape resilient green spaces that enhance urban life, from rooftop farms to neighbourhood parks, exploring the interconnections between people, place and ecology. With fieldwork, site analysis and industry collaboration, you'll build a strong landscape vocabulary while tackling pressing challenges like climate change and biodiversity loss, empowering you to design inclusive outdoor environments that connect communities and honour the natural world.

Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Biophilic Design



Craft, Materiality, and Form

This diploma shapes designers who think through materials and express ideas through crafted objects. You will develop a strong understanding of form, craftsmanship, ergonomics, and contemporary making.

Diploma in Design (Landscape and Architecture)

This diploma builds strong foundations in landscape, urban, and architectural thinking. You will learn to create meaningful outdoor and built environments through ecological awareness, spatial planning, and material exploration.

The Programme Offers:

- Training in landscape design, architectural concepts, spatial analysis, and site planning
- Exploration of sustainability, climate-responsive design, and Southeast Asian environmental contexts
- Studio-based learning with model-making, prototyping, and digital visualisation



Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Biophilic Design

This degree develops designers who integrate nature, sustainability, and human experience into spatial and environment design. You will explore regenerative futures, ecological thinking, and Southeast Asian environmental contexts.

- Advanced concepts in biophilia, sustainability, ecological systems, and living design
- Research-informed design practice with strong regional grounding
- Cross-disciplinary collaborations with architecture, landscape, and environmental experts
- A launchpad into roles in spatial design, regenerative design, environmental design, and consultancy



Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Design Practice

This three-year honours degree empowers you to shape design as a purpose-driven practice. Deepen your craft in one of four design domains of 3D, Communication, Spatial or Fashion and challenge assumptions and learn in a collaborative environment with an interdisciplinary faculty.

- Interdisciplinary collaboration across University of the Arts London (UAL), including theatre, dance, fashion and media
- International exposure through study trips, placements and collaborative labs
