It was one that set the foundation of my theatre career. It allowed me to try, fail, learn, and try again, in a safe environment.

2. Share with us some of the differences you have observed in the English and Mandarin Theatre scene in Singapore?

There's actually a lot more similarities. When it comes to differences, I will say it depends on the production company's style and culture.

3. What were some challenges you faced starting out and how did you overcome them?

Finding a footing in the industry was definitely not easy. At the beginning, there were a lot of cold calls to make and auditions to attend, followed by tons of rejection. However, once people know you work hard and have a great attitude, one door leads to another. The important thing is to stay true to yourself and be grounded.



### 4. Share 3 pointers to your juniors who are about to graduate soon?

The industry is small. Everyone knows everyone or at least knows someone who knows someone else. This would mean that people in the industry talk and share resources. My three pointers would be:

- 1) Make sure to work hard and have a great attitude.
- 2) Persevere because you will get beaten down many times.
- 3) Take care of your instrument (body, voice, mind).
- 5. What do you enjoy most about your job?

That I get to be a vessel of empathy and shine light on perspectives.
