

CERAMICS (8 SESSIONS X 3 HOURS)

This course aims to introduce learners to basic skills in ceramics making. Fundamental techniques such as pinching, coiling, slabbing, hollowing and glazing will be covered. In addition to acquiring the essential skills for clay making, learners will amass the ability to apply knowledge of essential concepts relating to space, structure, proportions, composition and textures to their artwork. Learners will be designing and producing 3-Dimensional ceramic artworks during the course. This course is recommended for enthusiastic beginners who wish to explore the art of ceramics making.

Please note that wheel-throwing is not introduced in this course.

Course Content

- Processes of clay making
- Pinching, coiling and slabbing techniques
- Creation of imaginative character using pinching technique
- Exploration of pinched and slabbed artworks by professional artists
- Glazing techniques
