



Advisory on COVID-19 Precautionary Measures

The well-being and safety of the NAFA community is the academy's top priority. In the best interests of our students, NAFA has put in place precautionary measures to safeguard our community against the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19). These measures are aligned to the guidelines set by Singapore's Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health.

Health & Travel Advisories

All students are required to follow advisories issued by the academy. Students are advised to defer all travel abroad. Overseas study trips have been cancelled or postponed, while student activities and certain CCAs are suspended till further notice.

Temperature Screening & Check-in via SafeEntry

Access to our campus buildings will be controlled. All students, staff and visitors are required to pass through designated temperature screening stations and are to register via the 'TraceTogether' mobile app or 'TraceTogether' token. Those who do not pass the screening will be denied entry.

Wearing of Masks

All students, staff and visitors are required to wear a mask at all times on campus.

Face shields should not be used as a substitute for wearing a mask, except for persons who have health conditions that may result in breathing or medical difficulties when a mask is worn for a prolonged period of time.
