Orientation Matters

Parent(s) and/or guardian(s) are not permitted to accompany students during Orientation. They can visit the campus during Open House in January.

6. What is the attire for Orientation, class and workshops?

Students are expected to be properly and decently attired on campus. The following are considered inappropriate attire:

- Singlets, shorts and slippers
- Clothing that exposes midriff or show visible cleavage or undergarment
- Transparent (see-through) clothes
- Clothes printed with vulgar or offensive words or pictures
- Revealing low-rise pants

Students are also required to adhere to specific attire and footwear guidelines for workshops, laboratories and studios

16. CPF Education Loan Scheme and application procedure:

Singapore Citizens/ Singapore Permanent Residents who are pursuing full-time MOEfunded diploma and bachelor's degree courses and who are eligible for MOE Tuition Grant (TG) can apply for a loan from their own or their parent's CPF savings to pay for the tuition fees.

The total amount withdrawn for tuition fees plus accrued interest has to be repaid in full with cash to the CPF Board, one year after graduation or termination of studies, whichever is earlier.
